Government of India (GOI) has approved a new sponsored scheme National Livestock Mission for implementation during 2021-22 to 2025-2026. The objective of the scheme is to support entrepreneurship development for rural poultry, sheep and goat, piggery, feed and fodder and also improvement of breed of sheep, goat and as well as fodder production. The scheme is implemented by Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying. The new modification scheme guidelines were issued vide OM dated and has been made available at <u>WWW.dahd.nic.in</u>.

2. As per the new guidelines under the scheme, the Department of A.H & Veterinary Services, State Government of Nagaland invites applications from individuals, FPOs, JLGs,SHGs and section 8 companies for availing benefits under the Entrepreneurship programme for establishment of the following projects.

a) Rural Poultry Entrepreneurship Model for establishment of parents farm of 1000 birds of Low Input Technology. Hatchery for production of chicks and brooder mother unit for brooding and rearing of the chicks.

c). Piggery Breeder farm for production of piglets and fattening of piglets as per the new guideline is listed below:

d). Feed and Fodder Entrepreneurship for establishment of Silage making unit. Fodder Block making unit and Feed Mixed Ration plant.

3. The Following clarification are also approved by empowered committee:

a). The applicant may also be eligible for applying for more than one component in **NLM-EDP** simultaneously.

b). More than one adult member of a family maybe also be eligible to apply and may avail benefits under the NLM-EPD scheme, provided she/he fulfils the eligibility criteria.

4. The detail of project, eligibility criteria, list of documents eligible for funding has been annexed at Annexure I

5. The eligible Beneficiaries who are fulfilling the criteria under the scheme. Shall apply through the online portal <u>www.nlm.udyamimitra.in</u> though a form for application and required a documents which has been provided at **Annexure III**. The last date of submission of expression of Interest is from the date of publication.

6. The offer of EOI shall be valid for a period of 45(forty five) days from the date of publication, initially which may be extended if required by department.

7. Evaluation criteria has been provided at Annexure I. the EOI will be screened and evaluated for short listing inter alia based on their eligibility conditions and verification. Agencies/Individuals who qualify and short listed. However subsidy will be provided depending on the the budget availability under NLM scheme.

8.where there is any indication that a conflict of interest exists or may arise, it shall be the responsibility of the Eligible Entity to disclose and inform the State Implementing Agency will be the final arbitrator in case of potential conflicts of interest. Failure to notify any potential conflict of interest will invalidate the application.
