In pursuance to Govt. approval No. MED-9/1/89(Pt-1)/307 Dated Kohima, the 3rd June 2025, interested candidates from bonafide Indigenous Inhabitants for the State of Nagaland are invited to undergo 2 (Two) years course in FHW (Female Health Worker) /ANM (Auxiliary Nurse Midwife) Training for the academic session 2025-2026 at School of Nursing, District Hospital Tuensang.

1. Candidate should be PU (10+2) in any stream with 40% from recognized English medium School Board and 45% from Recognized National Institute of Open School.
2. Unmarried Female Candidates.
3. Minimum and maximum age for admission will be 17-25 Years as on 1st January 2025.
4. Number of seats is 30 (Thirty).
5. Application Forms will be issued during Office hour at Directorate of Health & Family Welfare (Room No. 210) at the cost of Rs. 200/- (Two Hundred) only.
6. Issue of application forms will be on 23rd to 27th June 2025.
7. Last date of submission of application form shall be on 1st July 2025.
8. Issue of Admit Card will be on 18th & 19th August 2025.
9. Application form duly filled up along with necessary document/certificate duly self- attested should be submitted along with the ST/SC/BT and Indigenous Inhabitant Certificate, which is compulsory.
10. Incomplete application, if submitted, will be summarily rejected. List of rejected application will be paste in the Office Notice board.
11. No separate calling letter will be issued.
12. There will be written and viva test (Date will be notified later)
13. No Government job is assured after completion of Training.
14. Backward Tribe Reservation policy (15%) will be followed as per Govt. Notification No.HTE/RESEV/23-1/2012 dated, Kohima the 30th May 2016.
15. Person with Disability (PWD) may also apply for FHW/ANM under the categories, DW-Dwarfism/LC Leprosy cured/AAV-Acid Attack Victim.
